5. have access to accessible documents and paperwork

6. request any additional communication tools needed to fully participate in projects



7. receive support to understand and contribute to any projects and joint-working initiatives

8. be offered the same opportunities as non-disabled colleagues

9. be recompensed appropriately for their work
