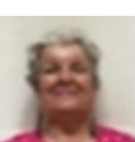


Join the Power and Control Group to speak up for people with learning disabilities in Islington.

We are very happy to be recruiting new Power and Control Group Workers to help us carry on doing the great work that we do.

About the job



The Power and Control group workers speak up for people with learning disabilities in Islington. They spread the word about their rights.



They speak up for people with learning disabilities (mild moderate and severe learning disabilities) at big meetings like The Islington Partnership Board.



The Islington Partnership Board look closely at things like health, housing, employment and keeping safe.

They make sure that things are working for people with learning disabilities in Islington.



The Power and Control group also go to other meetings. They might be meetings with professionals, other organisations, or service user meetings.

They speak up at meetings about what people with learning disabilities in Islington want from services.



The Power and Control group also help to plan services.

They help to check if services are good for people with learning disabilities, and spread the word about what good support looks like.



They make information easier to understand by creating easy read documents.



They go to training, conferences, and events.

They also give training to professionals about how to support people better.



The group meet up every week, on Wednesday afternoons at the Elfrida Society.

During the COVID-19 meetings are online.



Managers join meetings to give presentations and ask to the group about what they think.



Group workers are provided with an iPad and are trained and supported to use it to attend video meetings.

What would I get paid as a Power and Control worker?



- **Wages:** £10.85 per hour (The London Living Wage), paid at the end of every month



- **Working hours.** Around 2 hours per week, usually on Wednesday afternoon.



- **Annual Leave entitlement:** You can have 12 hours of paid time off per year.



What do you need to do to be a Power and Control Worker? (If you need support to do these things, that is ok.)



You should be able to come to group meetings every week - unless you are sick or on holiday.



You should be on time for when the meetings start.



You should agree to keep to the group's ground rules. You should treat everyone equally and fairly. Ask us if you would like to see accessible copies of our policies.



You should be able to listen to other people with learning disabilities in Islington about issues and ideas for the future.



You should be able to speak up at meetings about ideas or issues. You might be speaking up about what other people think, or what you think.



You should want to make services better for people with learning disabilities in Islington and be passionate about speaking up for their rights.
